- Incomplete applications will not be reviewed for admission. All required documents, including this form, and a recommendation from a professor must be uploaded in Søknadsweb by the February 1, 2019 deadline. If your recommender wants to email the recommendation, it must be sent by February 1 to iss@stolaf.edu
- Most of the scholarships available to applicants from USA and Canada are partial scholarships. Applicants should be prepared to cover a substantial portion of the on-campus program fee. None of these scholarships cover international travel, books/supplies, or personal expenses.
- The number of applicants greatly exceeds the number of available scholarships. Competition for scholarship is very tough.
- Scholarships are only awarded to on-campus students and are non-negotiable. It is the recipient's responsibility
  to evaluate if they can afford participation at the ISS after reviewing the costs and scholarship amount.
- Recipients must follow the scholarship terms and conditions.
